

## The High Arctic: Beyond Baffin Bay

Follow the Midnight Sun to a world of Arctic wildlife, glistening ice, and hardy Inuit communities on remote, windswept shores.

#### DAVIS STRAIT & BAFFIN BAY

Once a major whaling ground, these waters are rich in wildlife from beluga whales and walruses to flocks of dovekies, small auks that live so far north few people ever get to see them. Get fitted for your complimentary commemorative Polar Parka as we head deeper into the Arctic, and listen to the Expedition Team's briefings to learn what lies ahead. As you sail the scenic waters, enjoy the magical long shadows and golden light of the midnight sun.

#### ELLESMERE ISLAND

Spend three days in this remote corner of the Arctic with a stark, imposing beauty that is difficult to describe. Some compare its odd mix of glaciers, desert, mountains, and fjords to Mars or the Sahara Desert, yet it supports a surprisingly robust ecosystem that includes 151 species of moss. In summer, purple saxifrage and Arctic poppies bloom, and musk oxen, wolves, and polar bears roam undisturbed by humans.

#### NORTHWEST GREENLAND

Northwest Greenland is a region even most Greenlanders have never visited. The rugged terrain and giant ice sheet have isolated the few year-round communities, and travel is mostly by boat, snowmobile, or dog sled. As a result, the people here live a traditional Inuit subsistence lifestyle in a pristine Arctic environment with abundant wildlife and dramatic, otherworldly scenery.





## The Northwest Passage & Nunavut

Follow famous polar explorers to the elusive Northwest Passage, and discover treasures of the tundra from musk oxen to profound silence.



#### IQALUIT, DIANA ISLAND & ERIK COVE

Nunavut covers one-fifth of Canada, yet has only around 40,000 residents — a vast, untouched wilderness waiting to be explored. In Iqaluit, discover Inuit culture from the legislative building's sealskin benches to cafés serving Inuit tea. Wildlife including the rock ptarmigan, Nunavut's official bird, thrives on the cloudberry, crowberry, and other shrubs covering uninhabited Diana Island and Erik Cove.



#### THE NORTHWEST PASSAGE

Spend eight days exploring the eastern side of the Northwest Passage, just as Amundsen, Franklin, and others did on their voyages. Traverse the icy waters by Zodiac® and cross the rugged landscapes on guided nature walks. Go ashore in Cambridge Bay to see the Canadian High Arctic Research Station, and listen to local residents speak their endangered language, Inuinnagtun.



#### SISIMIUT & EVIGHEDSFIORDEN

Colorful colonial houses reflect Sisimiut's history of Danish rule, but your guided walk through town is pure Greenland. See the unique "dog village" where the town's huskies are kept, learn about musk ox wool, and taste local specialties like mattak and seal blubber. Or join your Expedition Team on a hike of part of the Arctic Circle Trail. Then take a Zodiac or kayak along Evighedsfjorden to watch icebergs calve and drift slowly out to sea.

# Wild Labrador Coast: Missions, Fjords & Wilderness

Walk and hike a landscape shaped by ice and sea over millennia and delve into the Inuit's ancient cultural traditions.

#### NUNAVUT

Admire the intricate tapestries and carvings of Pangnirtung and explore the old whaling station of Kekerten Island. Then have your binoculars ready for thrilling wildlife encounters around uninhabited islands where Atlantic walruses, seals, and breeding seabirds thrive. Scan the shorelines for polar bears patrolling the rocky terrain, watch for whales feeding in the waters, and keep your eyes peeled at night for the Northern Lights.


#### TORNGAT MOUNTAINS NATIONAL PARK

Only a handful of roads run through otherwise unspoiled wilderness on the Labrador Coast, and none of them lead to the Torngats. It's one of the most remote and inaccessible national parks in Canada, known as the "place of spirits" by the Inuit. The folded layers of rock are some of the oldest on Earth, but the place feels unchanged by time. Polar bears roam in Nachvak Fiord, wolves hunt caribou, and the tundra puts on a brilliant display in its short season.

#### NEWFOUNDLAND & LABRADOR

Vikings, Inuit, missionaries, and fishermen have called this coast home, some more successfully than others. Join the Expedition Team in Hebron to see what remains of the Moravian Mission, abandoned after being plagued by illness. In Nain, visit the Illusuak Cultural Centre to learn about Inuit culture. The one-time cottage hospital and fishing outpost of Indian Harbour provides a glimpse into Newfoundland maritime culture, and L'Anse aux Meadows is home to an excavated Norse encampment.








## Southern Caribbean to Rio

Bask in warm waters, adjust your eyes to brilliant green rainforest, and discover the vibrant energy of Afro-colonial cultures.



#### **SOUTHERN CARIBBEAN**

Divine beaches and underwater wonders are just a few of the Southern Caribbean's charms. Find history in crumbling colonial forts, restored plantation houses, and 200-year-old family distilleries. Discover rare scarlet ibis among the mangroves, white egrets in the trees, and green turtles in the sea. Included experiences let you learn, relax, or stretch your legs — whatever you're in the mood for.



#### DEVIL'S ISLAND & DAYS AT SEA

Join your Expedition Team to uncover the ruins of the notorious Cayenne Penal Colony. Made famous by the bestselling memoir *Papillon*, the institution closed in 1953, yet many of the original buildings remain. The decaying structures create a striking contrast against the lush tropical vegetation and glorious coastal sea. Leisurely sea days bookend your visit, offering time to lounge by the pool or search for Atlantic spotted dolphins from the Bridge.



#### BRAZIL

Brazil's coastal cities are intoxicating. Get acquainted with Natal's rich history as you walk through Ribeira, the oldest part of town. Glide down the stunning Búzios coast by Zodiac®. And take your pick of two included expeditions in Parati: Discover colonial gems and watch artisans at work in one of the best-preserved Portuguese old towns in Brazil, or beach-hop by schooner surrounded by emerald waters and dense rainforest.

## Antarctica, Falklands & South Georgia

Explore glacier-draped channels, teeming penguin colonies, and stately parades of monumental icebergs.

#### FALKLAND ISLANDS

The Falkland Islands' windswept slopes are an ornithologist's dream. Black-browed albatross circle overhead while rockhopper penguins skip comically among the tussock grasses. Imperial shags nest along rocky outcrops where curious striated caracaras watch intently. During your three days in this remote archipelago, we'll find the best landing spots among West and East Falkland and the over 200 smaller islands that surround them.



Around 450,000 pairs of king penguins breed on South Georgia, along with several other species of penguins, while albatrosses, petrels, and other birds nest along its shores. A few million fur seals hustle about, and hundreds of thousands of elephant seals gather in haul-outs so immense they must be seen to be believed. Spend three days among the abundant wildlife and visit the grave of British explorer Sir Ernest Shackleton in Grytviken.

#### **ANTARCTICA**

Walk and hike across vast, untouched landscapes seldom seen by other travelers. Cruise alongside towering icebergs by Zodiac®. Kayak through a maze of sea ice. Seabourn Venture is equipped to navigate the glittering ice and take you ashore for unforgettable wildlife encounters, and our days are flexible and dictated by nature. Revel in the freedom to watch a playful pod of killer whales, a calving glacier, or whatever the moment provides.












