Inaugural 21-night Norwegian Journey



11 JULY – 1 AUGUST 2023, 21 nights

An extended exploration of Norway's fjords

To the traveller, the urge to cross the Arctic Circle is almost as strong and the North Pole itself. For this reason, we offer an extended journey into an immense landscape to discover its wonders on the most intimate terms.

Into the narrowest fjords of Norway, we are dwarfed by the majesty of sheer cliffs and tumultuous waterfalls. We explore brightly painted towns warmed by the Gulf Stream then sail across the Arctic Circle to see glaciers shouldering their way to the sea. Glacier hiking, ice kayaking or hanging a "Polar Ten" surfing await in Tromsø and the Lofoten Islands. Trains race across glaciers left over from another age whilst fast boats and mountain stairways that take us deeper into nature and a new heaven in southwest Norway. The uniqueness of light draws us to Skagen then onward into the cool Scandinavian mist of Copenhagen. There is no question, that the pull of the Arctic Circle makes this journey "next-level", indeed.

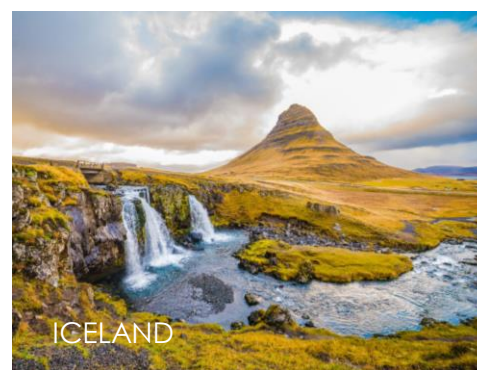

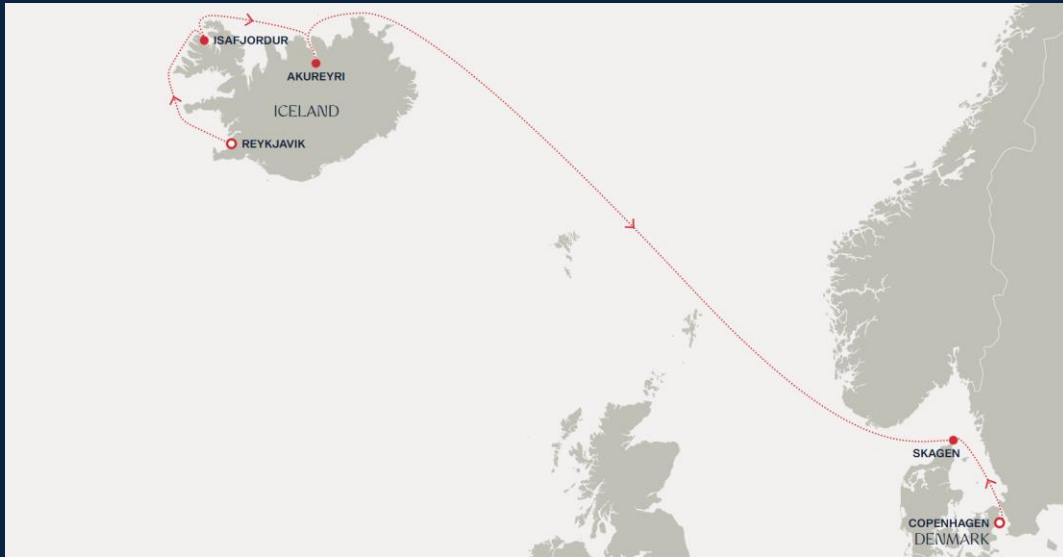

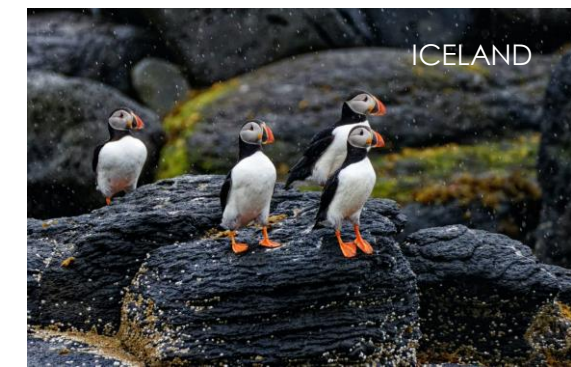
The Wild Heart of Iceland

Multilayered, mesmeric, and utterly indefinable, Iceland fulfils dreams of eco-curious experiences. Emotions are amplified standing before the uncontrollable energy of waterfalls, unearthly blue lagoons, and staggering sites that ring the Golden Circle around Reykjavik. Sailing northward around a filigreed coastline of peninsulas—each with its own geological marvels, stories, and wildlife.

Thunderstruck, you gaze upon a mountainous valley that shelters Puffins, Arctic Foxes, and idyllic Ísafjörður village. Alight on trails leading upwards to spy bird-watching cliffs, waterfalls plucked from a fantasy, and glaciers that are expanding. Skimming the rim of the Arctic Circle, you sail onward through the halls of Heaven and into the deepest Icelandic fjord to find Akureyri; a buzzing whale-watching outpost also renowned for Goðafoss and Icelandic horses, which are the purest breed in the world. Leaving behind huffing volcanos and exploding geysers, you venture southward to Skagen then disembark in Copenhagen to linger in its achingly cool design and historic palaces.

Awe-inspiring and gorgeous, the Scottish archipelago of Shetland's 100 islands are scattered like green pieces of a puzzle across a cobalt sea whilst the enigmatic Orkneys shelter prehistoric settlements, aged whiskey and Kirkwall's fashionable high street. Your adrenalin quickens as otherworldly Iceland comes into focus as whales and ice flows make your heart leap. Heaving geysers and volcanos feed milky blue thermal lagoons set against black lava rock landscapes. Skim just below the Arctic Circle, take flight over glaciers, spelunker into magma caves, and pinch yourself to believe you are in a world so phenomenal. Nestled on the coast of the northernmost tip of mainland Europe, Skagen, known for the unique luminosity of its landscape, fulfils your dreams of uncommonly sandy beaches then comes the mythological Copenhagen, a haven of castles.

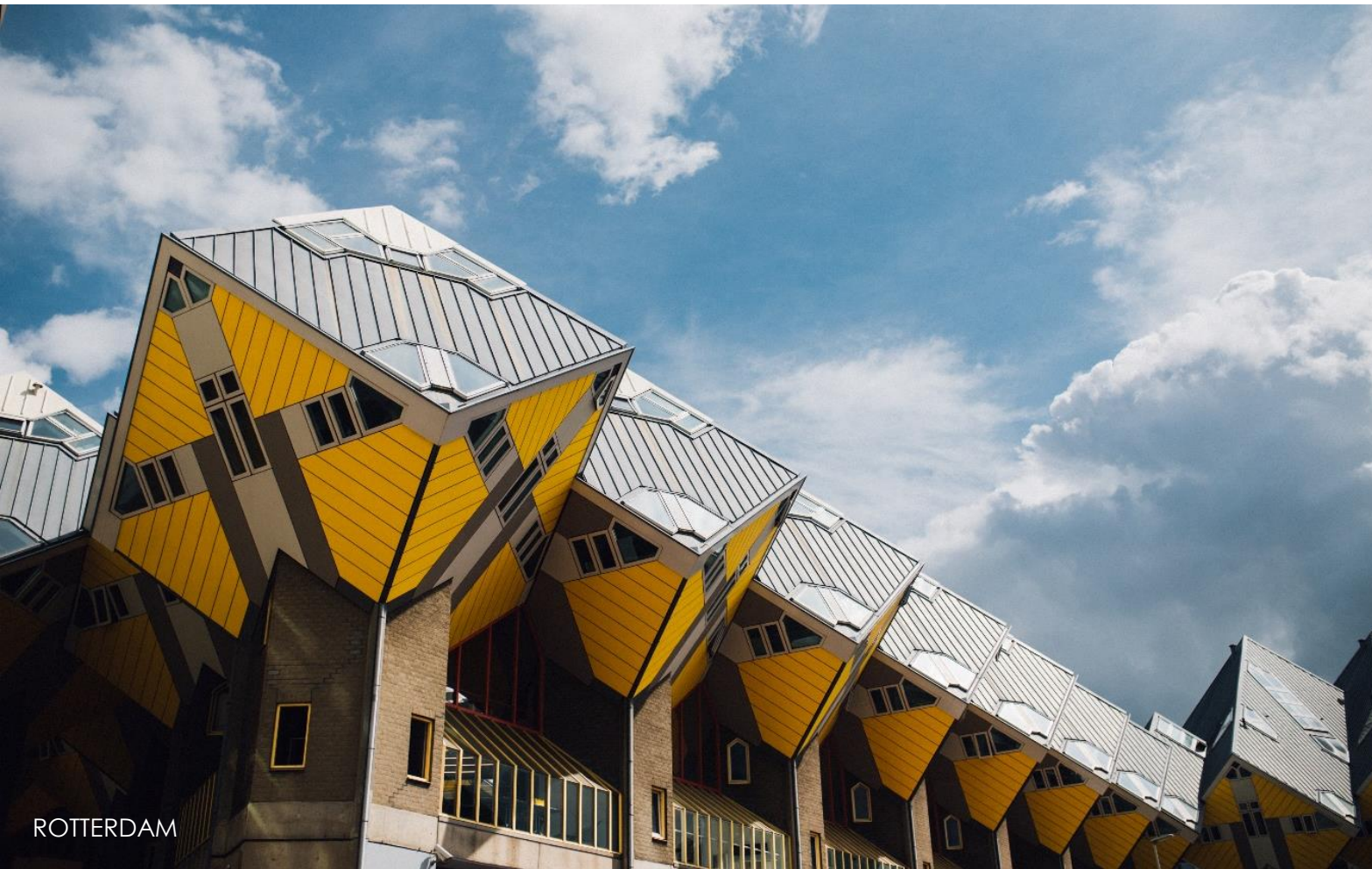

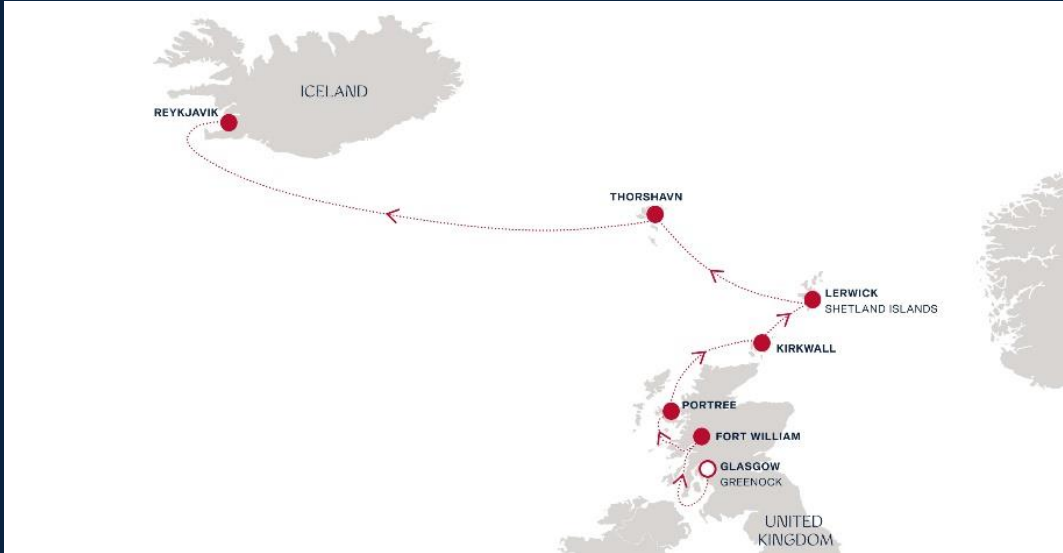

A phenomenon in nature occurs when golden sunshine dances across misty, green glens to create a rare effect of celestial light. The luxury of this luminosity begins in Glasgow, where we seek the interlude of modern and ancient sites from Lock Leven to the “armadillo” performance arts centre and charming Buchanan Street, comparable to London’s West End.

We follow a crinkled shoreline to find Port William, the “outdoor capital of the UK” and gateway to the prettiest glens including Glencoe and Glenfinnan, made even more famous in the movies Skyfall and Harry Potter respectively.

The light in Skye, Orkney Islands and Shetland Islands is exceedingly remarkable and spotlights some of the most geologically diverse landmasses in the world. Chasing the midnight sun, we call on the remarkable Faroe Islands, a fairy-tale of unfathomable allure that seems to come straight out of a Jules Verne novel. Our journey’s final salutation to the sun in Iceland begins enlightening experiences on the land.

Inaugural 16-night United Kingdom, Faroe, Iceland Journey



An extended exploration from Scotland to Iceland

Chasing celestial light that dances across green glens and glacial bays, journey from Scotland to Iceland with wild wonders in-between.

Walk in the footsteps of ancient kings in Edinburgh, where our overnight coincides with the global performance of the Military Tattoo. Cross paths with poets who protest there “may be dragons” in the Highlands of Invergordon and Loch Ness, then find Neolithic standing stones that are older than Stonehenge on the Isle of Lewis. Glasgow provides an interlude of modernity before venturing to Scotland’s prettiest glens of Glencoe and Glenfinnan. In Skye, we find a light as evocative as its geologically diverse landmasses. The Orkney Islands exceed all expectations whilst the Shetland Islands mark the northernmost point in the UK. Turning toward the midnight sun, we visit the unfathomable Faroe Islands then make our final sun salutation in Iceland where enlightening experiences await within the Golden Circle and treks across the “white desert” of a massive ice cap.
