Highest standards

Experience, hardware and **responsibility** go hand in hand

We know how to do expeditions: our many years of experience allow us to plan, prepare and perform these highly complex journeys. Together with their team, each of our captains has mastered many nautically challenging routes in extremely remote regions. State-of-the-art navigation, positioning and communications systems place our new expedition class in a technical league of its own as well. Particularly in the polar regions, we check the route daily, look for even more impressive alternatives and react flexibly to the weather and ice. And yet no ship technology can show where polar bears wander, curious pods of whales appear and tabular icebergs reach up into the sky-this is where

our feel for the right moment and passion for discovery come into play. Only cruise operators like us who meet the requirements of the Polar Code of the International Maritime Organisation (IMO) and are certified accordingly may travel in polar waters. Our new expedition ship is extremely stable and fitted with exceptional technical equipment to allow it to move through polar waters for longer periods without stopping for provisions or fuel. With the highest ice class for passenger ships (PC 6), it can push aside the broken pack ice and, if necessary, travel safely through solid ice cover around 90 cm (35 in.) thick.



- We have decades of expedition experience with award-winning route concepts and many pioneering feats
- Again and again, our expedition ships have mastered legendary passages – including 20 journeys through the Northwest Passage, 5 through the Northeast Passage, 4 semi-circumnavigations of the Antarctic and even one complete circumnavigation of the Arctic
- Maximum safety, maximum adventure: highest ice class for passenger ships (PC 6), higher density steel plates and many additional ribs in the main ice area of the hull





Built with foresight Not just up close, but **at the** heart of the experience

The new expedition class offers more open deck space than any other expedition ship. Hear the ice crack as you stand on the bow and watch the bizarre formations pass by below you. Float above the ocean on two extendible glass balconies on the Sun Deck and enjoy perfect views. Feel yourself to be part of nature. The Observation Deck is also built with "foresight" with various observation levels and mounted binoculars. Inside, the Observation Lounge shows just how comfortable pioneering spirit can be, as you enjoy the 180-degree view through the floorto-ceiling windows. The ship's shallow draught and great manoeuvrability take you to the heart of experiences in a way large ships can't.






