Safety in a class of its own

Experience, hardware and responsibility go hand in hand

We know how to do expeditions: our many years of experience allow us to plan, prepare and perform these highly complex journeys. Together with their team, each of our captains has mastered many nautically challenging routes in extremely remote regions. State-of-the-art navigation, positioning and communications systems place our new expedition class in a technical league of its own as well. Particularly in the polar regions, we check the

route daily, look for even more impressive alternatives and react flexibly to the weather and ice. And yet no ship technology can show where polar bears wander, curious pods of whales appear and tabular icebergs reach up into the sky – this is where our feel for the right moment and passion for discovery come into play. Only cruise operators like us who meet the requirements of the Polar Code of the International Maritime Organisation (IMO) and are certified accordingly

may travel in polar waters. The HANSEATIC inspiration is extremely stable and fitted with exceptional technical equipment to allow it to move through polar waters for longer periods without stopping for provisions or fuel. With the highest ice class for passenger ships (PC 6), it can push aside the broken pack ice and, if necessary, travel safely through solid ice cover around 90 cm (35 in.) thick.

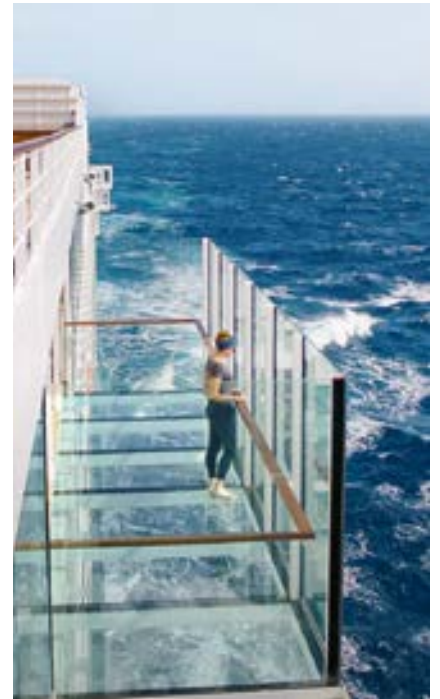

Built with foresight

Not just up close, but **at the heart** of the experience

The new expedition class offers more open deck space than any other expedition ship. Hear the ice crack as you stand on the bow and watch the bizarre formations pass by below you. Float above the ocean on two extendible glass balconies on the Sun Deck and enjoy perfect views. Feel yourself to be part of nature. The Observation Deck is also built with

“foresight” with various observation levels and mounted binoculars. Inside, the Observation Lounge shows just how comfortable pioneering spirit can be, as you enjoy the 180-degree view through the floor-to-ceiling windows. The ship’s shallow draught and great manoeuvrability take you to the heart of experiences in a way large ships can’t.

Sustainability and prevention

We take responsibility

Experiencing the beauty of our planet brings certain responsibilities along with it. For that reason, our aim on cruises with our new expedition class is to preserve vulnerable habitats and raise awareness of how we can cultivate a respectful attitude towards flora and fauna. Those who explore the world with us know that these treasures are worth protecting.

The combination of various measures ensures that the highest standards of sustainability are met around the world. We are also committed to continuously improving the environmental performance of our small, state-of-the-art ships so that we protect the very things that have made expedition cruises with Hapag-Lloyd Cruises so fascinating over the decades.

ENVIRONMENTAL COMMITMENT

- Decades-long membership of IAATO (International Association of Antarctic Tour Operators) and support for well-known organisations that aim to protect the Antarctic.
- All of our Antarctic cruises are approved by the German Federal Environment Agency (Umweltbundesamt).
- As a member of AECO (Association of Arctic Expedition Cruise Operators), we promote responsible, sustainable and safe tourism in the Arctic.
- We are involved in the "Clean Up Svalbard" project; together with our guests, we gather rubbish and ensure it is disposed of correctly.
- We are committed to helping people and nature in cruise destinations worldwide – also together with specialised partners and organisations.
- Hapag-Lloyd Cruises offers sustainable eco excursions that take place on foot, by bicycle or using forms of transport with low CO₂ emissions.

ENERGY EFFICIENCY

- Reduction in fuel consumption of around 30 % thanks to optimised route management and avoidance of top speeds.
- Reduced fuel consumption thanks to the newly developed hull.
- The PROMAS rudder with a special propeller also helps reduce fuel consumption and therefore means lower emissions.

RESOURCE MANAGEMENT

- Seawater desalination technology on board for our own treatment of drinking water.
- Waste separation prior to disposal on land in accordance with the MARPOL regulations, ensuring less impact on the environment.
- Power management and decreased electricity consumption thanks to energy-saving light bulbs and LEDs.
- Ballast water management to ensure that flora and fauna are not carried into regions where they are not indigenous.
- Hapag-Lloyd Cruises has been reducing the use of unnecessary plastic and disposable items for many years already.





EMISSION REDUCTIONS

- Already since 2020, we have been using marine gas oil with a maximum sulphur content of 0.1% both in our main cruising areas, such as the Arctic and Antarctic, and in all other regions – meaning that this fuel is used all year round by the entire fleet. By voluntarily foregoing heavy fuel oil, we are reducing sulphur emissions as well as particulate emissions.
- The new-build ships are fitted with an SCR catalytic converter, which further reduces nitrogen oxide emissions.
- Below-average CO₂ emissions according to our EEDI certificate.
- The bow thrusters and stabilisers run on eco-efficient ecological oil.
- Our expedition fleet is equipped for shore power and makes use of this technology where possible.
- TBT-free underwater paint.

RESPONSIBILITY AT OUR DESTINATIONS

- We prepare our guests both in advance and on board before they visit fragile ecosystems.
- Wherever possible and reasonable, we buy local produce to shorten our transport routes and support the local economy.

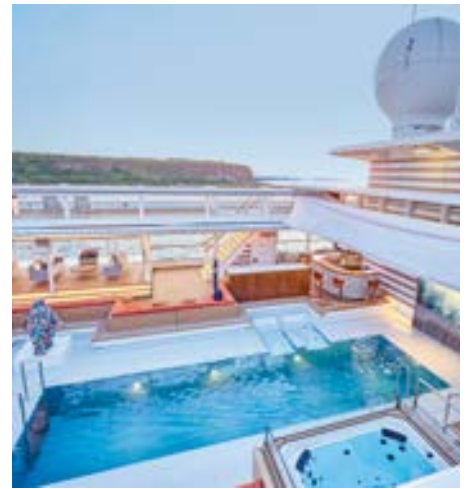

The semi-circumnavigation of the *Antarctic* is considered one of the greatest adventures of our times. 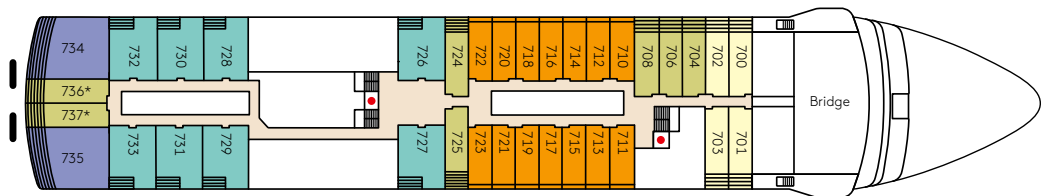

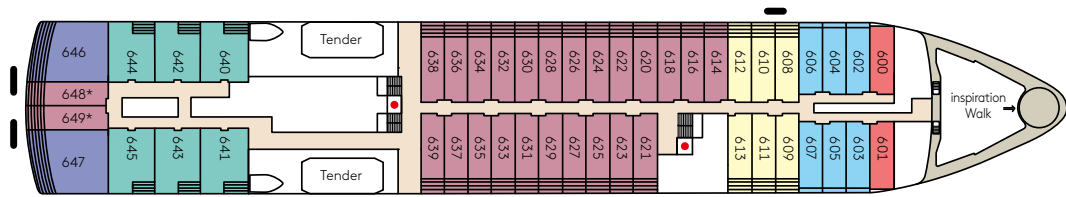

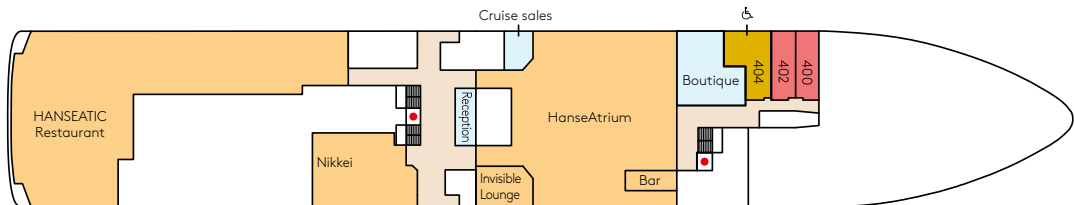
