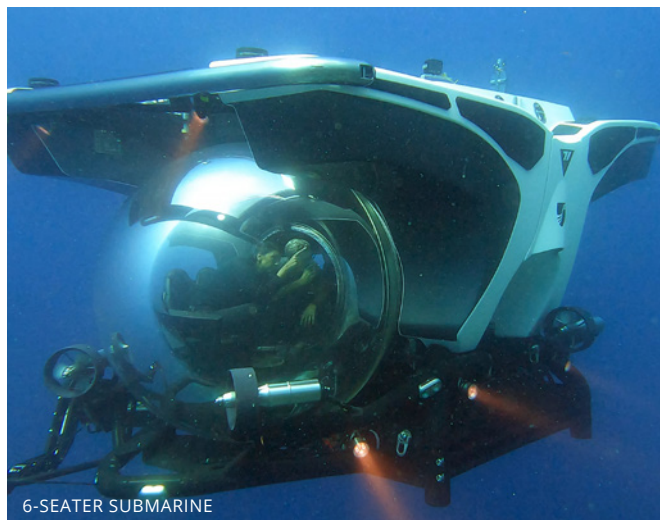

Seabourn Venture's 2023 and 2024 seasons include expeditions to the Arctic, Antarctica and the Amazon where you may cruise in Zodiacs under teeming bird cliffs and along jungle rivers, kayak among stately icebergs and tropical coral islands. Visit Viking ruins, ancient Inca sites and remote villages. View whales, walrus and seals up close and cruise in submarines past vivid reef walls and towering underwater ice cliffs. Snorkel unspoilt tropical coral gardens glittering with iridescent fish, trek to earth-shaking waterfalls and shining blue-white glaciers.

Seabourn Pursuit's inaugural voyages will feature the Amazon and Antarctica from October 2023. In 2024 the ship will voyage to the remote islands of the South Pacific - then beyond to Australia's rarely visited Kimberley region.



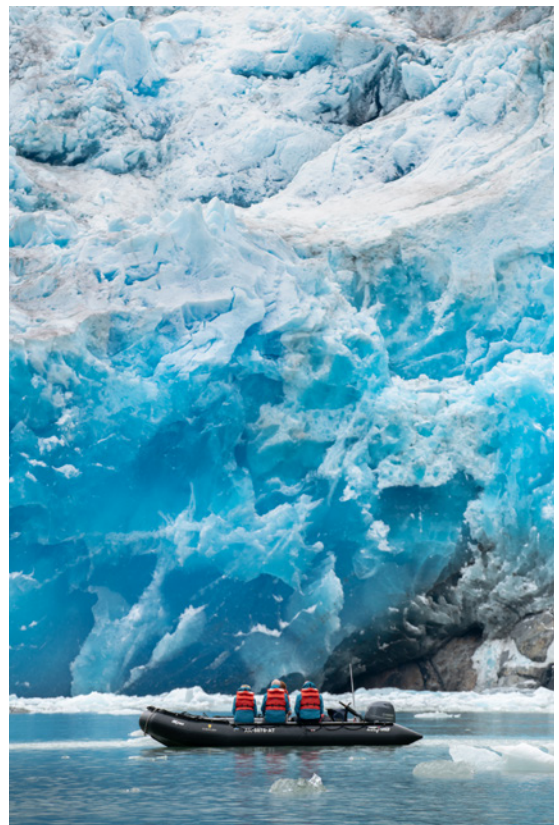

ARCTIC EXPEDITIONS 2023 & 2024

Taking in views of rugged mountains, ice-blue glaciers, and lush greenery is one of the most sought-after activities for expedition travellers. Experience nature's seasonal extravagance in Svalbard, Iceland, Greenland, and the Canadian Arctic.

Cruise in Zodiacs under teeming bird cliffs and kayak among tall, stately icebergs under the Midnight Sun. Thread a kayak among sculpted icebergs observing the whales, walrus, seals, reindeer, polar bears and more that fill this remote region with life.

Visit Viking ruins and ancient Inuit sites. Explore Svalbard's breathtaking fjords, immense Icelandic waterfalls, the grandeur of Greenland's glaciers and polar bear-haunted beaches in remote Baffin Bay and Nunavut.

THE ORKNEYS

THE UNITED KINGDOM & IRELAND 2023 & 2024

Britain and Ireland are often overlooked in the world of expedition however, our voyages around these coastlines will visit many remote locations that are sites of historical, cultural, and natural significance; Rugged coastlines and outlying islands with tremendous nesting bird populations which only come to land in the late spring and summer months. Incredible Neolithic sites showcasing early farming communities and religious sites of longstanding significance.

Visit Iona, where St Columba established an Abbey in the year 563, then join a Zodiac cruise to see Staffa Island and peer into Fingal's Cave. Explore the remote and fascinating double UNESCO World Heritage site of St Kilda. the vast seabird colonies of Copinsay by Zodiac or marvel at the population of Atlantic puffins at Canna in the Inner Hebrides. Then take in County Donegal's stunning scenery and Galway's traditional Irish culture. Or head to Norway's magnificent fjords and the Midnight Sun.

THE ANTARCTIC EXPERIENCE

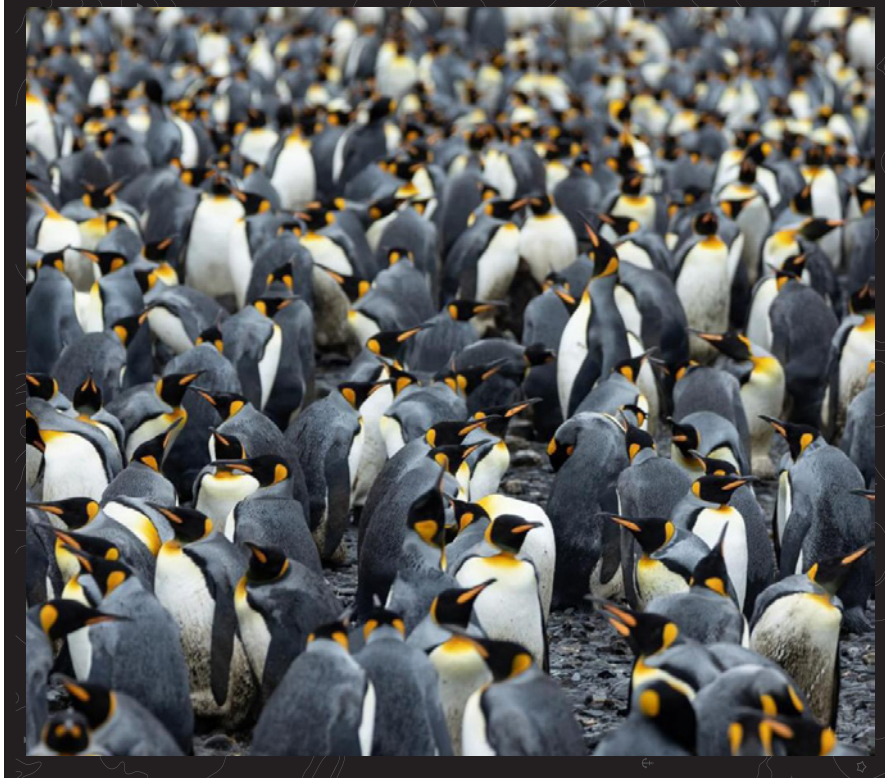

Antarctica has been a source of inspiration for as long as humans have been aware of its existence. For these 5-7 days, you are privileged to experience this truly wild place at a level of luxury previously unimaginable.



SOUTH GEORGIA

Feel overwhelmed when landing in South Georgia, a naturalist's paradise. The stunningly beautiful and rugged island is a wildlife sanctuary with over 450,000 pairs of King Penguins, over a million Macaroni Penguins, and many other bird species including albatrosses. Elephant and Fur seals populate most coastlines. History is present all around South Georgia, as seen in the remains of the whaling station which played an important role in early exploration and the island's history.

THE AMAZON 2023 & 2024

During expeditions in the Amazon River, explore varying environments shaped and differentiated by the river itself, divided into three major regions: You'll visited flooded forests and Backwater Tributaries, where the river is wide, slow and winding. In the Frontier Amazon, our ship passes near to the forest where there is less frequent evidence of human population. In the Peruvian Amazon encounter indigenous populations and discover age-old human traditions surviving unaltered by the outside world.

Travelling by zodiac with the Expedition Team, you will learn how the rise and fall of the river relates to the rise and fall of fortunes. Watch for evidence of how the local people deal with their sometimes-inhospitable environment. Also possible are wildlife encounters including sloths, howler monkeys, birds and squirrel monkeys.

EASTER ISLAND

SOUTH PACIFIC FROM CHILE TO MELANESIA 2024

Follow the intoxicating scent of frangipani to the South Seas, where a vast string of island gems lies awash in vibrant colours, emerald peaks, sapphire lagoons, black pearls, shimmering white sands. Kayak around dazzling atolls, hike to ancient marae sites, snorkel over pristine reefs, and go birding for red-tailed tropicbird and blue lorikeet, all while expertly guided by Expedition Team members. Share a bowl of kava with friendly islanders and slip inside a custom-built submarine to watch Picasso triggerfish, blacktip reef sharks, and other marine life dart about the kaleidoscopic corals.

Explore Juan Fernandez Archipelago by Zodiac and search for wildlife such as pink-footed shearwaters and the South American fur seal. Explore the hardly inhabited Pitcairn islands; iconic Easter Island with its giant Moai heads. At Fiji's remote Yasawa Islands, meet the friendly locals and explore the incredible limestone formations of the Sawa-I-Lau Caves. Then venture into the mysterious cults and dances of Vanuatu.

The mainland and islands surrounding Papua New Guinea and West Papua are incredibly rich and diverse, offering incredible snorkeling and diving over coral reefs that are protected and thriving. The culture of the islands is rich and varied, and you'll enjoy welcome dance performances and hear locally performed music. Learn about life in some of the most remote wildernesses of mainland West Papua and meet villagers on some of the smallest islands of both Papua New Guinea and West Papua.
