CRUISE THROUGH THE CORINTH CANAL

The idea of an Ancient Corinth ruler, started by Roman emperor Nero, and finally completed by the French, the Corinth Canal separates the Greek mainland from the Peloponnese. It shrinks down to less than 25 metres wide at the very bottom, which means that sailing through the Corinth Canal on an ocean-going ship is a very special experience.

Many of today's vessels are too large to negotiate the Canal, however on board smaller ship, *Braemar*, you can experience gliding between the towering cliffs, with rock-faces passing by so close that you can almost touch them.

Our smallest ship, *Braemar*, is the largest ship to have transited the ultra-narrow Corinth Canal. • *Braemar*'s size also comes to the fore as you dock within one mile of the centre in most of your ports of call, making your exploration ashore even easier • Discover fascinating ancient sites such as Olympia, the birthplace of the Olympic Games; Athens' Acropolis with its famous temple ruins, the Parthenon; the cliff-top citadel of Lindos Acropolis; and the stunning Minoan Palace of Knossos

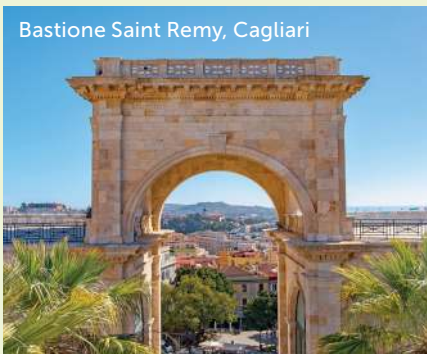

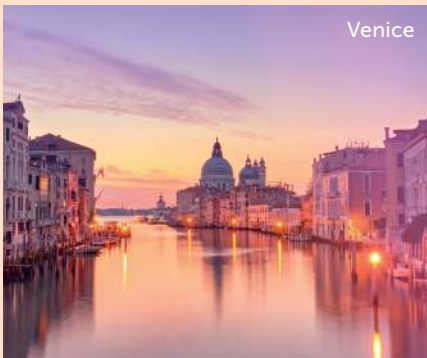

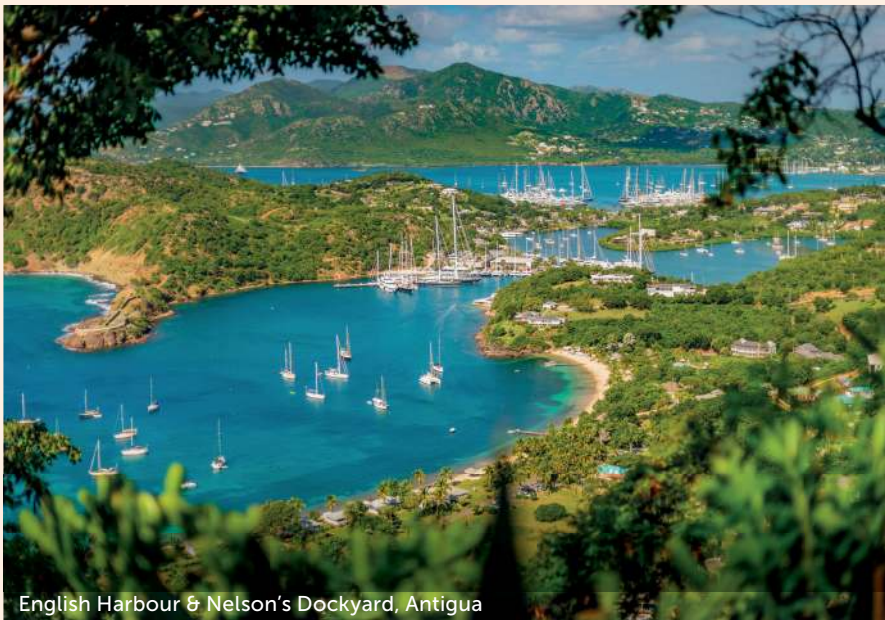
