As part of our dedication to sustainability, we focus on making a positive impact and advocating for environmental, social, and economic responsibility. We're proud to be part of The Travel Corporation (TTC) and further its **How We Tread Right** strategy, which is anchored to the United Nations Sustainable Development Goals. Under the guidance of Uniworld's Sustainability Officer, Julie Higgins, we've made significant progress across several areas of operation. Read our recent highlights below.

01

CLIMATE ACTION

We've become the only cruise line to join **Path2Zero**, a research project aimed at reaching net-zero carbon emissions in Europe. We're contributing financial support, advice, and the expertise of our captains and engineers, who are helping test real-world solutions in the program's "Living Labs."

02

FOOD WASTE

Over the last couple of years, we've piloted a comprehensive food waste measurement and reduction system known as **Leanpath** on select ships. So far, we've eliminated over 50 tons of food waste, equating to a 36% reduction. In other numbers, that's 93,305 meals, 354 metric tons of CO₂, or 1,247,516 bathtubs of water!

ELIMINATING PLASTIC

We're eliminating single-use plastics across our fleet by introducing refillable toiletry dispensers, bamboo room keys, cloth laundry bags, and more. Along the way, we've discovered that these high quality, sustainable alternatives also provide a more luxurious experience than their disposable counterparts.

Our **MAKE TRAVEL MATTER® Experiences** take guests on unique and immersive local experiences that show them how their travels can directly and positively impact the destinations they visit. We currently feature MTM Experiences on 67% of our itineraries and are on our way to having them on 100%.
