



DAY 1: Basel (Embark)

DAY 2: Basel

Basel is a cultural and artistic powerhouse, with all sorts of galleries, theatres, and museums. DAY 6: Cruising the romantic Rhine River, Koblenz

DAY 2: Nuremberg

For a holiday extravaganza, look no further than Nuremberg, which boasts the largest and grandest Christmas Market in all of Germany-and that's really saying something. The "Gingerbread Capital of the World" pulls out all the stops during the holidays, as you'll see for yourself on a panoramic tour guaranteed to put you in a festive mood. You could not ask for a more perfect place to begin an exploration of Christmas traditions than Nuremberg. Stroll through the castle gardens and enjoy breathtaking views of the city, then walk through a maze of cobblestone lanes down to the central Market Square. There, spread out before the Church of Our Lady, is the largest Christmas Market in Germany. A special Captain's Welcome Reception and Dinner will be prepared for you this evening.

DAY 3: Bamberg
