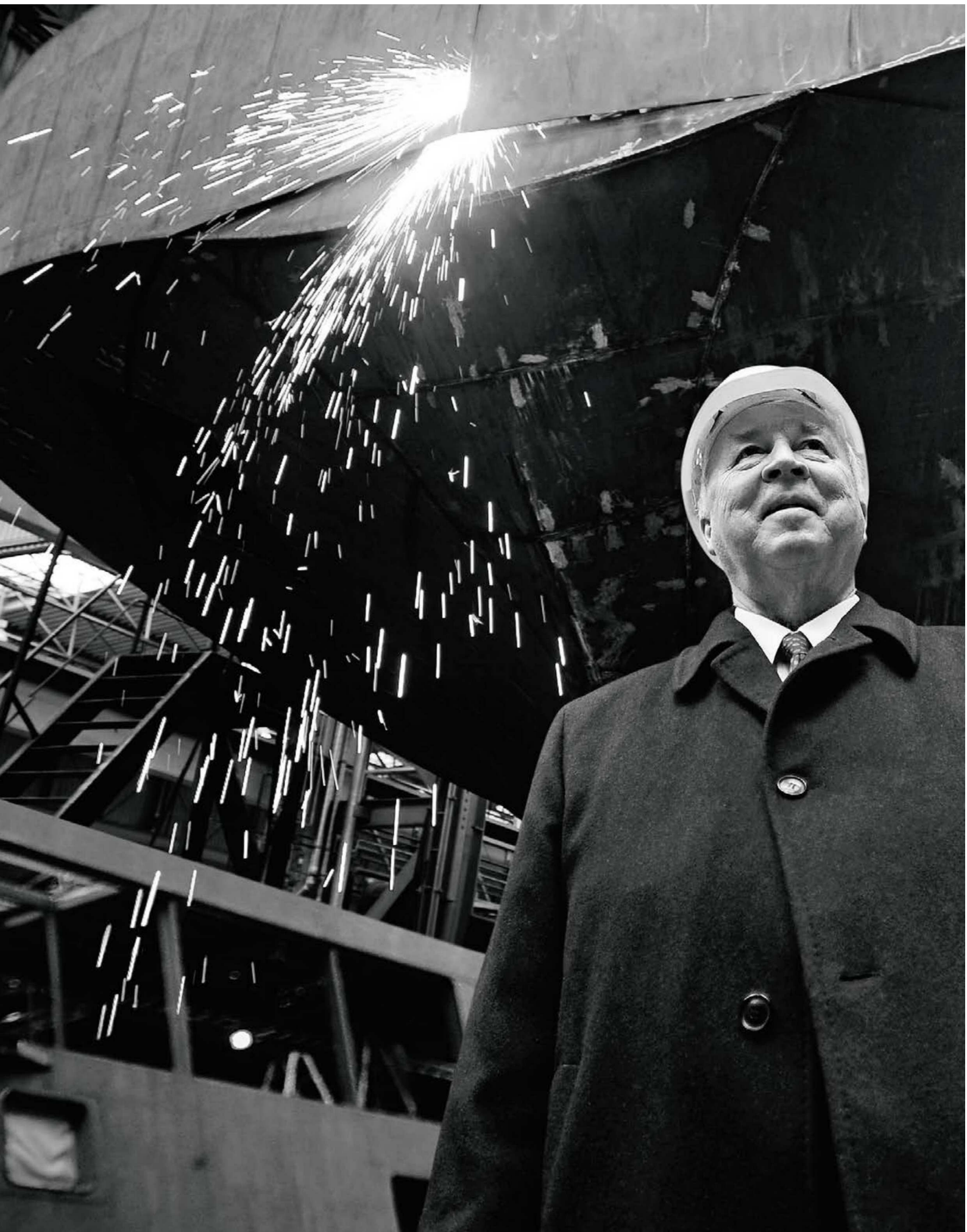




Thus began a journey that has marked the rise of river cruising as the fastest-growing travel segment. Soon our guests grew eager to journey with us on the iconic waterways of Europe—the Rhine, Main, Danube, Seine and Rhône Rivers—and farther afield to the Douro, Nile and Mekong Rivers. Since then, we have been doing what comes quite naturally to us—innovating the travel experience in a way that enriches and engages our guests—and along the way we have received many accolades from travelers and industry insiders alike. We are honored by their consistent top ratings and high praises that have made us the world’s most award-winning river line.

At Viking, we believe we owe our success to our desire to build vessels that are carefully designed to connect our guests to local culture, with an understated interior elegance that never upstages the destination. In 2012, we introduced our innovative Viking Longships, designed to navigate Europe’s storied waters. Their agility allows them to dock in the heart of riverside cities and villages while providing a spacious onboard atmosphere, thanks to a patented design that maximizes space and generous, open areas filled with natural light. Full-size verandas, true two-room suites and the most al fresco dining available bring destinations even closer. And with an enriching variety of events and activities on shore and on board, these state-of-the-art ships fully immerse you in local culture. Our Longships® have taken river voyages to a new level of sophistication and comfort.

But we did not stop there. In response to requests from our loyal guests, we applied the same small ship

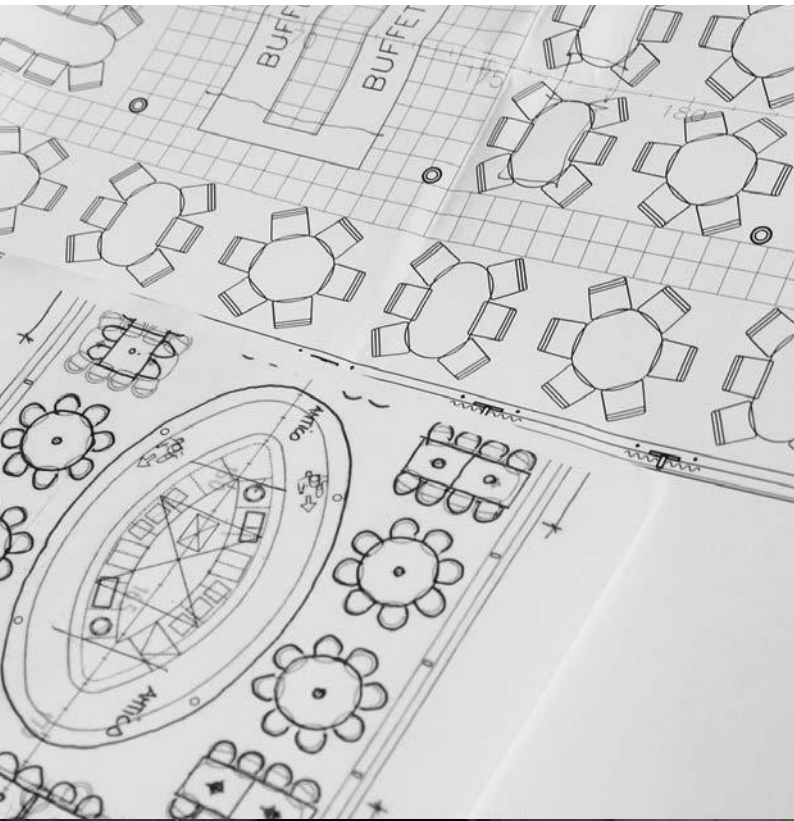
experience to the seas, launching our destination-focused ocean voyages in 2015. In our first year—as well as consistently after that—we have been named the #1 Ocean Line by *Travel + Leisure*.

To create the unique Viking experience at sea, we have reimagined the vessel from the inside out, and have built the world’s most elegant fleet of sister ships. Our streamlined design creates a spacious and inviting home that connects you to the places you have journeyed so far to see. With a veranda in every stateroom, the world’s beauty is close enough to touch. Throughout, the Scandinavian design of our ships celebrates our Nordic heritage: clean lines, colorful woven textiles and light woods that evoke the Viking spirit of discovery and connection to the natural world.

Celebrating our 25th anniversary with the launch of Viking Expeditions® in 2022, we now explore all seven continents with our new voyages to Antarctica, the Arctic and the Great Lakes. And in welcoming the *Viking Mississippi*, we ushered in a new era of modern river voyages to America’s heartland.

Viking has more than 250 awards to its name and we are immensely proud that our river, ocean and expedition voyages have all been named #1 by the readers of *Condé Nast Traveler* in the 2023 Readers’ Choice Awards. It is the first time a travel company has been voted #1 in all three categories at the same time, and this honor only strengthens our resolve to continue creating destination-focused experiences for curious travelers.

OUR VIKING HERITAGE

Our ocean ships and enriching itineraries carry our Viking heritage forward, ushering in the next generation of exploration and discovery.

During the great Viking Age, enterprising Norsemen established coastal trading settlements throughout Europe and maneuvered along Russia's rivers to access overland trade routes. They also launched ships west, sailing across oceans to settle in Iceland and Greenland and setting foot on North American soil in the 10th century, the first Europeans to do so. As shipbuilders, the Vikings were innovators whose designs evolved to accommodate their seafaring needs. The ships' powerful hulls were constructed to ply open oceans while their maneuverability let them slip nimbly into small ports. Built for speed and endurance, Viking ships were recognized, respected and imitated the world over.

The success of the Viking era can be credited to a rich Scandinavian culture wedded to the sea. At Viking, we cherish our connection to these seafaring pioneers. Their spirit inspires everything we do, from the journeys we offer our guests to the innovative ships we build.

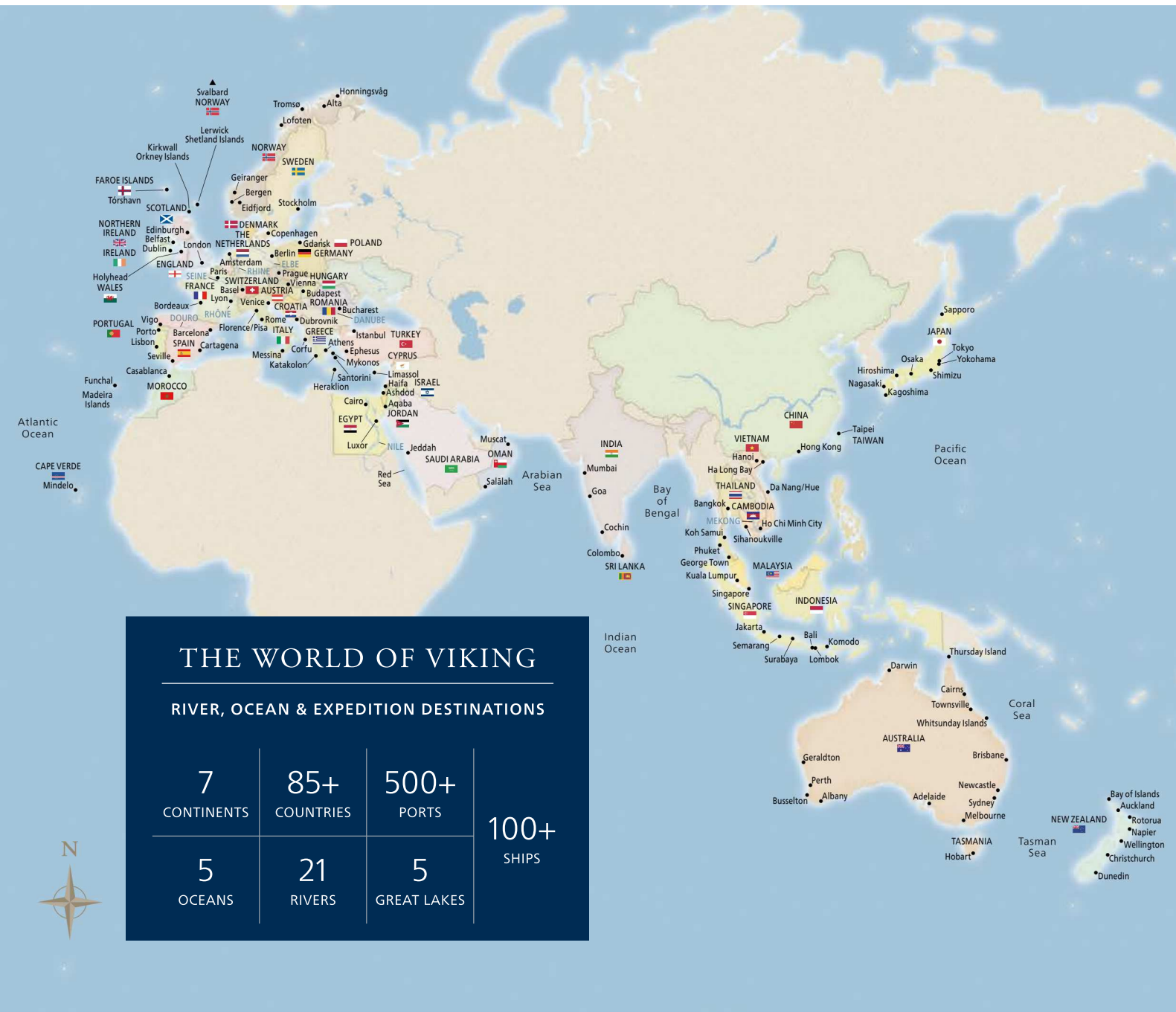
BUILDING UPON OUR RICH HISTORY

The simply designed ships of the Viking Age, which weathered the brunt of open ocean waters and easily maneuvered into small ports, were carved from oak and other elements harvested from nature. The clean, streamlined designs of these earliest Scandinavian explorers are the inspiration for our own Viking river, ocean and expedition ships. Many of the materials that went into these elegant vessels were created by hand from nature, not by a mass production line. In proud Nordic tradition, our wood grains show their imperfections, giving you a feeling for their pure character. Natural stains, matte finishes and subtle accents of slate, teak and limestone exude warmth and a variety of textures. Colorful textiles are woven in true Scandinavian spirit. Onboard accents—from rugs and tapestries to window treatments—borrow from the beauty and patterns of the earliest Nordic artists and craftsmen from Norway to Iceland. And our open public spaces with vast windows bring

in natural light, whether solar, lunar or glow from the aurora borealis. With so much of the natural world living in our sister ships, we like to think that they could have been forged by the pantheon of Norse gods.

Driven by an insatiable spirit of discovery, the Vikings sailed to Europe's farthest shores. That adventuresome spirit shapes the immersive cultural exploration infused in our shore excursions, enrichment lectures, entertainment and onboard cuisine. In addition, our itineraries follow in the Vikings' wake, tracing many of their original trade routes, like those through the Baltic Sea and along Norway's stunning coast...along the North Sea to France, the British Isles and Faroe Islands...across the Atlantic to Iceland, Greenland and North America...and deep into the Mediterranean Sea to the shores of southern Europe and northern Africa.

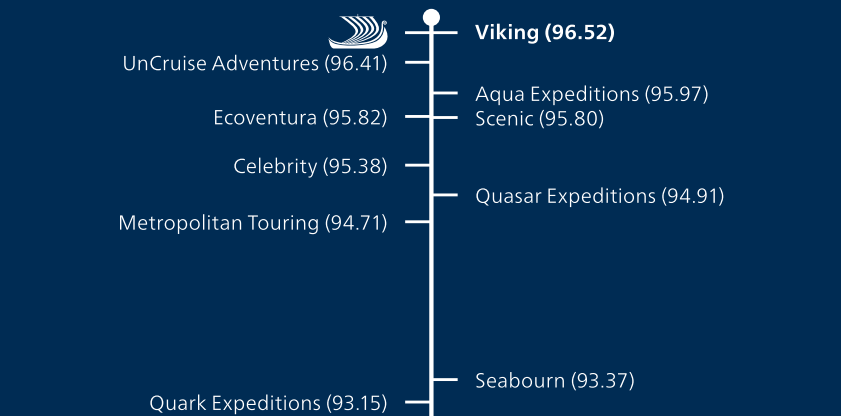

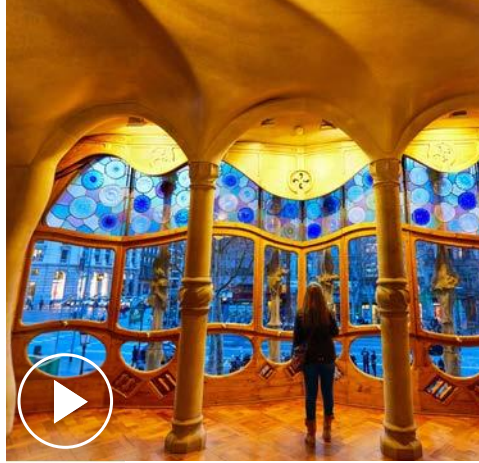

RESPONSIBLE TRAVEL

Viking is committed to delivering a superior travel experience to our guests, and also to operate responsibly wherever our journeys take us. The communities we visit are at the core of the travel experience, and we seek to work with local individuals and companies, creating long-lasting mutually beneficial partnerships.

In addition to Viking's direct contributions, our guests' discretionary spending fuels local economies. Spending more time in port than traditional cruise lines, providing an included shore excursion in each port, and encouraging rather than deterring guests from bringing local food and drink on the ship increases the economic impact our port calls have.

Perhaps nothing exemplifies our approach better than the wall art that adorns many of our ships' staterooms: Instead of meaningless hotel "art" by the meter, photographs of iconic sights and destinations all over the world are matched with drawings made by grade school children. This initiative, a joint effort with two rural Viking-sponsored schools in China has been expanded to include drawings from schoolchildren in Egypt and from communities along the Mississippi River.

Our lead scientific partner is the University of Cambridge's Scott Polar Institute, whose scientists will undertake fieldwork on board our expedition ships and will share their expertise with our guests.



Viking has partnered with the globally recognized Cornell Lab of Ornithology, whose ornithologists will regularly be on board, field testing new observation methods and providing guest advice and interaction.

CULTURAL & SCIENTIFIC PARTNERSHIPS

Viking experiences, from ship to shore, are designed for unparalleled access and cultural enrichment. We have established a variety of premier partnerships that build on our continued commitment to support enriching cultural programming and events. These partnerships—with some of the world's leading cultural organizations—bring a curated onboard experience to complement your time ashore.

Additionally, Viking has created the world's leading scientific enrichment environment in an expedition setting. Exclusive partnerships with the Scott Polar Research Institute at Cambridge University and The Cornell Lab of Ornithology—as well as other prestigious scientific institutions—match leading researchers and educators with each expedition.



TECHNOLOGY & THE ENVIRONMENT

At Viking, we are conscious of our responsibility to the environment and the regions through which we sail; thus, our ships are designed to the highest environmental standards. Our long-term success depends on our ability to develop programs that meet or exceed both the global regulatory frameworks as well as local regulations in the most vulnerable areas we explore, such as the Arctic, Antarctica, Europe's inland waterways, the Norwegian fjords or the Alaskan coast.

Our vessels, though dependent on shoreside infrastructure and supplies, operate as self-sustained entities, capable of providing electricity, water and waste treatment facilities. The careful management to minimize our environmental footprint is essential and all our vessels are designed to be environmentally responsible and efficient to operate. While each vessel class has specific operational characteristics, some key principles can be found across our entire fleet:

EFFICIENT USE OF SPACE—Because every bit of added weight results in extra fuel consumption, we are careful to add to our ships only what is needed, prioritizing optimal guest comfort and operational efficiency.

SLEEK HULL DESIGN—Our ocean and expedition vessels have been designed with energy-efficient hulls, propellers and rudders to reduce resistance in the water and therefore reduce fuel consumption.

DIESEL-ELECTRIC PROPULSION—Virtually all our ships use diesel/electric propulsion technology, where a series of electric motors drive the ship propellers, while the diesel engines act as a generator. Diesel-electric

technology is also future-proof: with time, it will be easy to replace diesel engines with more sustainable technologies, such as batteries and fuel cells.

SHORE POWER—The majority of our vessels can connect with shore power to reduce, where possible, reliance on fuel while in port. This allows operations with zero emissions and less noise. Our own docking facilities along Europe's rivers are being equipped with rapid charging systems to further reduce reliance on diesel fuel.

ADVANCED RECYCLING & WASTE MANAGEMENT—Our entire fleet is equipped with advanced wastewater treatment systems, ballast water treatment systems (ocean & expedition) and onboard trash compacting and recycling centers to minimize the generation of waste and enable responsible recycling in shore facilities.

ADDITIONAL FEATURES—Across our fleet, other measures in place to reduce our environmental footprint include: low-energy LED lighting resulting in a lower heat output, lower power usage and a longer life; waste heat recovery systems that use the heat from the engines as a free source for heating water; intelligent HVAC systems that reduce power when rooms are not in use; and noise & light pollution reduction technologies, reducing our impact on local communities and landscapes.

The above-mentioned technologies, in combination with vessel-specific characteristics, allow us to deploy a fleet of very efficient vessels that meet or exceed environmental regulations across the world.

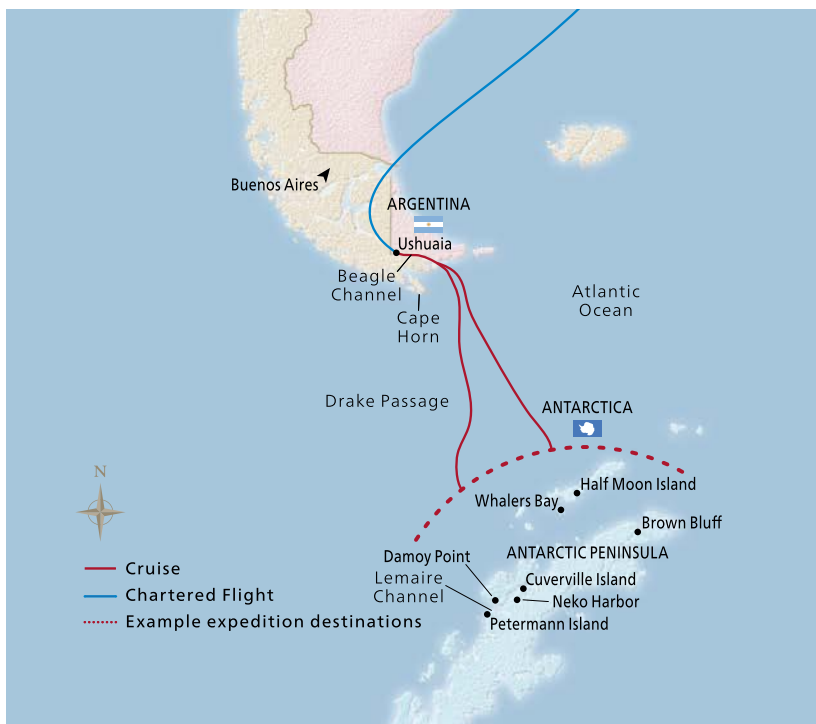

Torstein Hagen
DISCUSSES HIS TRIP TO ANTARCTICA

Discover how a childhood fascination with far-flung destinations and a lifelong passion for travel culminated in Viking Chairman Torstein Hagen's recent expedition to Antarctica on board the *Viking Polaris* during this exclusive conversation with award-winning photographer Alastair Miller.

Q: Mr. Hagen, you recently sailed to Antarctica. Did a letter you sent as a child to Ushuaia, Argentina inspire this trip?

A: As a young boy, I used stamps from my collection to mail a letter from my Norwegian home to Ushuaia. The letter was of course returned, and I kept it with me throughout my life, dreaming of one day visiting this faraway place—now the starting point for our Antarctic voyages.

Q: What struck you most about Antarctica?

A: My first and lasting impression is how huge it is. It is so overwhelming. Then, of course, you have the colors, the whites, the blues, of various shades. It is unlike anywhere else.

Q: Is this journey suitable for any adult?

A: If I can do this trip, anyone can.

Q: What wildlife did you see, and what activities did you do ashore?

A: We saw lots of penguins and came very close to whales. I also had my famous letter with me, which I got stamped at Port Lockroy.

Q: Can you describe some of the stateroom features of the *Viking Polaris*?

A: We have taken a lot of care to design the vessel for the environment in which it operates. Our Nordic Balcony staterooms provide a shelf at elbow level to stabilize binocular viewing or photography and warming closets for your gear.

Q: Can guests participate in scientific research on the ship?

A: Yes, there is The Science Lab with experts from various fields. I value scientific endeavors, being a physicist myself. Guests can learn about research efforts and engage with onboard scientists.

Q: Did you take any pre- or post-cruise extensions?

A: As a matter of fact, we went to Iguazú Falls and got soaking wet. It was like being a child again.

Q: Any advice for someone considering an Antarctic trip?

A: I would do it again.

Culture

ANCHORED TO THE SEA

Here, we bring to life the geography, resources and discoveries related to the Norwegian Sea

If you pulled Norway's crinkled coastline out into a straight line, it would circle the planet two and a half times. From north to south, the country measures less than 1,100 miles, but its coastline is an impressive 63,000 miles of fjords, bays and island shores. This glorious natural wonder was shaped during the last ice age when glaciers several miles high pushed into the land, resulting in dramatic soaring peaks like those seen on the Lofoten Islands.

A RICH SOURCE OF FOOD

Stretching out into the Norwegian Sea, the remote Lofoten archipelago shows off the sculpting power of nature. The islands are home to the world's greatest cod harvest. Each winter, the icy Arctic Ocean meets the Gulf Stream, attracting Arctic cod from the Barents Sea. These relatively warm waters are why the sea here remains ice-free all year.

Tørrfisk is dried and salted stockfish (usually cod), made in Norway for centuries. Traditionally dried outdoors by the wind and sun as a way to preserve nutrients, row upon row of fish hang on wooden racks along the shores of Lofoten, as they have done for 500 years.

These waters are also rich in herring, and the abundance of fish in turn attracts other animals. Humpback, minke, sei and orca come to feed, while the cries of puffin, kittiwake, gannets, gulls and guillemots pierce the sky.

Until the 20th century, the coast was sparsely populated, although the coastal Sami, who first colonized the land, have been living here for up to 4,000 years.

BEYOND THE HORIZON

From the deck of a ship, you sense a timelessness about the land, which is both wild and resilient.

You can understand the pull of the sea that Norwegian explorers like Roald Amundsen and Fridtjof Nansen felt. For many years, the Norwegian Sea was thought to be the edge of the known world. To sail across the sea was daring but also showed great navigation skills.

By the 8th century, the only European seafarers to dare sail far enough to lose sight of land were the Vikings. Waiting for favorable winds, and armed with plenty of provisions (like stockfish) they ventured in all directions, to create new settlements and forge new trading routes.

They navigated by the position of the stars and the sun. West, towards the sunset, meant they were headed for England; east (towards the sunrise) meant home to Norway. Symbolic of the Viking Age, the Vikings' longships were sophisticated beyond their time, recognized, respected and imitated the world over. Built not for comfort but for speed, agility and endurance, the ships' innovative design allowed the Vikings unparalleled access to faraway lands.

Exploration is part of the Norwegian DNA. By exploring beyond the horizon, Norwegians have mastered the sea and, in turn, depend on it for transport, resources and trade. The 14th century was Norway's Golden Age, a time of peace and growing international trade with Britain and Germany. This period of trade was controlled by the Hanseatic League, which established a trading center in Bergen. On Bergen's Bryggen wharf the preserved buildings of the Hanseatic League are a UNESCO World Heritage Site and serve as a reminder of the country's enduring link to the sea.

NORWEGIAN NETWORK

While far-flung islands and remote mainland locations on the edges of the Norwegian Sea were once cut off from the rest of the world, the area is now served by a vast network of data cables, providing a digital infrastructure for people in the region. The Lofoten Islands are now better connected than ever, with a thriving fishing industry, as well as visitors keen to hike in the mountains, fish in the coastal waters and, of course, witness the northern lights.

To sail the Norwegian Sea is to witness life along an eons-old coastline that is as mesmerizing as the sea itself. Under the dusky light of the midnight sun or the mid-winter blanket of darkness, the coast reveals tiny settlements in sheltered hills that appear unchanged through time. The cities along the coast, from Bergen to Tromsø and, in the far north, Honningsvåg, were built on fishing, trade and exploration, and they wear their heritage proudly. Wooden buildings from the 17th and 18th centuries line the harbor, where the fish markets sell the day's catch. Deep, yawning fjords, offer a route inland to mountains and glaciers.

Many countries have a history and culture firmly anchored to the sea, but none more so than the people of Norway.

Thunder Bay, Ontario, Canada

Thunder Bay is known as “Canada’s Gateway to the West” for its location at the final navigational point on the Canadian side of Lake Superior. In 1970, Fort William and neighboring Port Arthur were merged to form the City of Thunder Bay. Today, it is one of Ontario’s most vibrant cities and its Waterfront District offers views of the Sleeping Giant.

Silver Islet, Ontario, Canada

Located 1,200 feet below Lake Superior, this unique underwater mine was the world’s largest and most valuable silver mine, producing the modern-day equivalent of \$78 million before flooding in 1884.

Georgian Bay, Ontario, Canada

Georgian Bay, nestled in Ontario’s Lake Huron, boasts the world’s largest freshwater archipelago and Manitoulin, the largest freshwater island. Parry Sound, the world’s deepest freshwater port, is a key stop on the transcontinental Canadian Pacific route; Algonquin Provincial Park inspires artists; Killarney features the dramatic La Cloche range; and Frazer Bay offers breathtaking views in the Georgian Bay UNESCO Biosphere Reserve. Together, these places showcase the natural wonders of Georgian Bay.

Scenic Sailing: Soo Locks Transit

Opened in 1855 to allow ships to bypass the river’s 21-foot fall over rolling rapids, the Soo Lock’s innovative system—along with the Erie Canal built 30 years prior—was one of the great engineering projects of its day. Today, it guides ships past the twin cities of Sault Ste. Marie in Ontario and Sault Ste. Marie in Michigan; its bridge crosses over the Soo Locks, connecting the two cities.

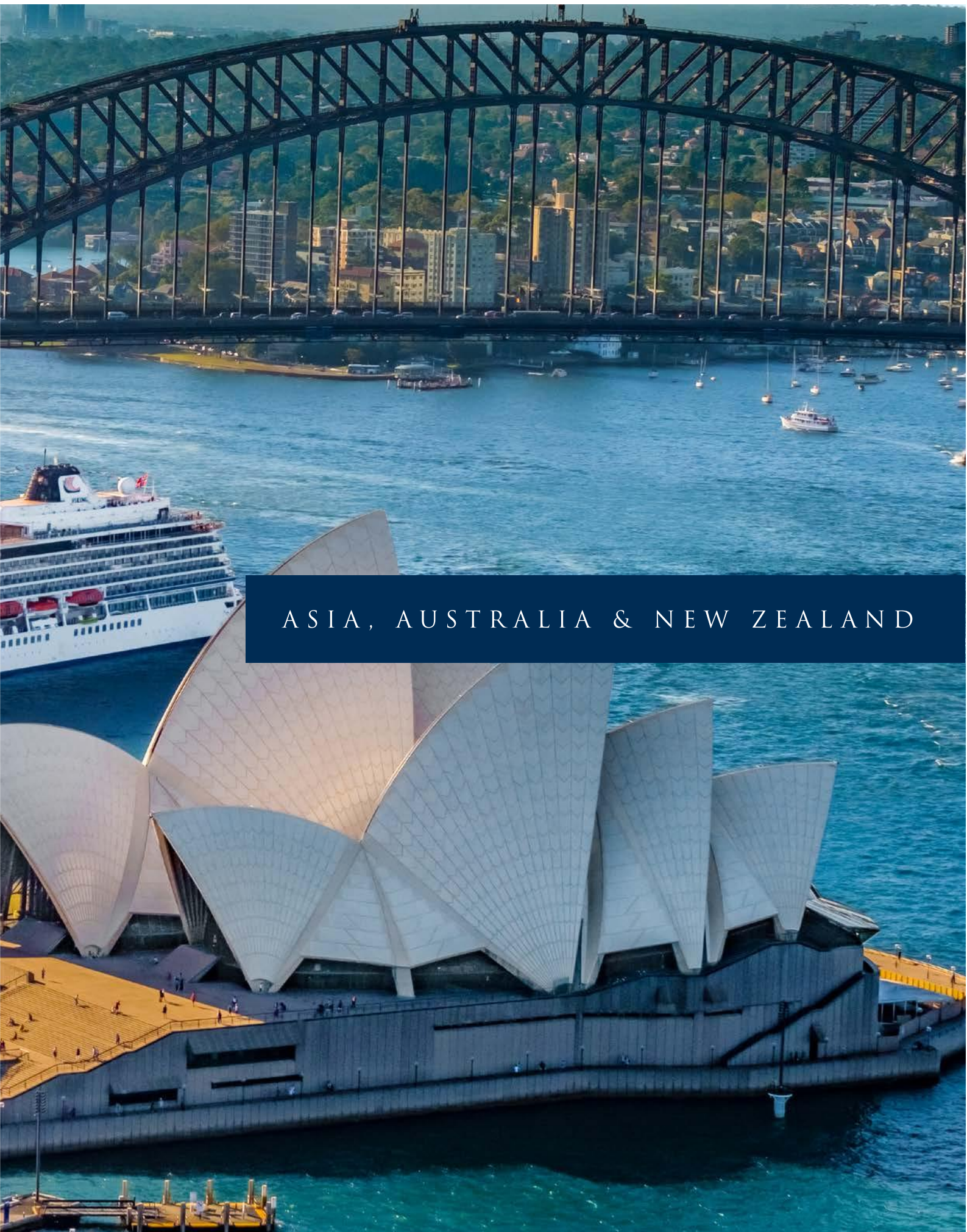
Mackinac Island, Michigan, US

More than 80% of Mackinac Island is protected as a state park, from its Greek Revival Grand Hotel and British-built Fort Mackinac to its preserved wilderness areas. This bucolic haven preserves gilded Victorian-era treasures along with car-free streets traversed by horse-drawn carriages. The perimeter road is the only state highway in the US that does not permit motor vehicles.

Milwaukee, Wisconsin, US

Milwaukee was first settled by Europeans in 1818, when the French-Canadian fur trader Solomon Juneau arrived. German, Polish and Eastern European immigrants followed, bringing with them a long tradition of beer brewing. For several decades in the 20th century, Milwaukee became the world’s most prolific beer producer. Today, the city is a vibrant center of art, history and culture. The RiverWalk—a pedestrian walkway along the Milwaukee—is a popular spot for enjoying relaxing strolls or viewing public art installations.

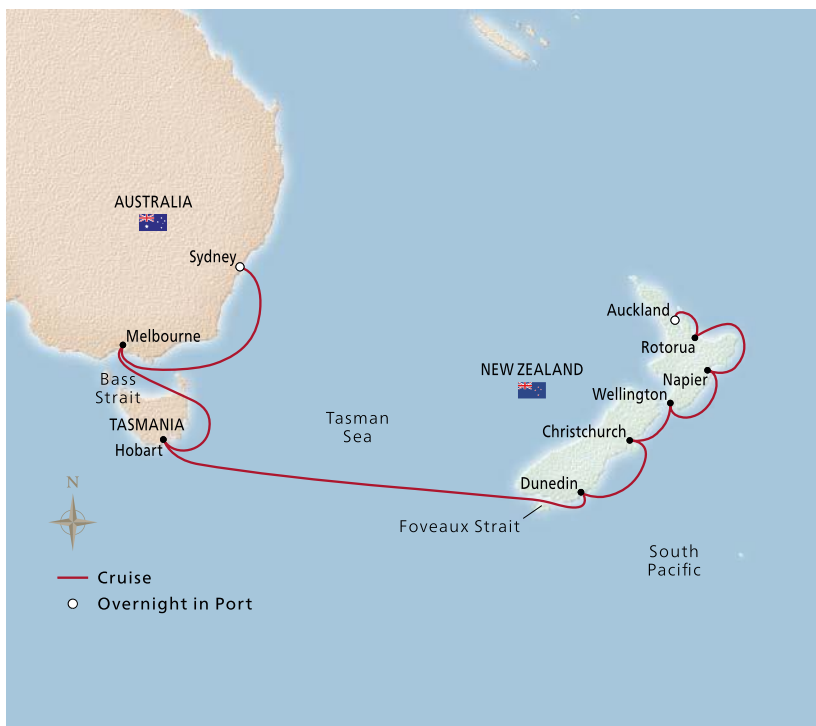

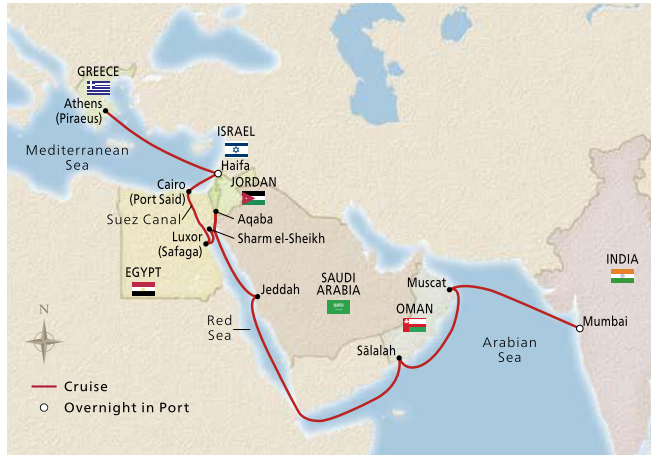

Fresh Vietnamese Summer Rolls

The perfect snack to transport your senses to
the street markets of Vietnam

A worldwide culinary favorite, Vietnamese summer rolls are one of Southeast Asia's best-known dishes. This light, delectable appetizer is packed with local ingredients from the Mekong Delta and South China Sea.

SUMMER ROLLS—also known as spring rolls—likely originated in China during the Jin Dynasty (266–420 AD) and were consumed to commemorate the first day of spring. By the end of the 3rd century, the Chinese had introduced the dish to Vietnam, and the rolls were adapted to suit Vietnamese preferences.

VIETNAMESE SUMMER ROLLS—known as *gỏi cuốn*, which translates to “salad roll”—showcase the finest ingredients available from the region's rice fields and floating markets. A typical preparation includes carrots, cucumbers, shrimp, peanuts, vermicelli noodles and fresh herbs rolled inside a rehydrated sheet of rice paper. This flavorful appetizer is served chilled with a spicy dipping sauce. Beloved by locals seeking to stay cool during hot, humid weather, these cold rolls are healthy, filling and portable. No matter when or where you enjoy them, summer rolls offer a taste of Vietnam's proud culinary heritage.



VIETNAMESE SUMMER ROLLS

Vietnamese fast food at its very best. Fillings can vary, but the aim is to pack the fresh ingredients into the rice paper for a light yet flavorful snack.

MAKES 8 ROLLS

1 pack Pad Thai rice noodles
8 rice paper wrappers
24 medium shrimp, cooked
1 bunch mint
1 bunch cilantro
2 or 3 Thai basil stems
1 carrot, peeled and sliced into fine matchsticks
½ cucumber, deseeded and sliced into fine matchsticks
Shredded lettuce
4 tbsp (60 g) salted peanuts, chopped

For the dipping sauce:

1 tbsp (15 g) sugar
Juice of 1 lime
1 tbsp (15 g) fish sauce
1 garlic clove, crushed
1 small red chili, deseeded and finely chopped

1 Cook the rice noodles according to package instructions, drain and reserve. Assemble all the filling ingredients, and pick the herb leaves from the stems. Make sure you have a bowl of cold water handy for the rice paper wrappers.

2 To assemble the rolls, soak each rice paper wrapper until it is pliable, then spread flat onto a cutting board. Arrange three shrimp in the center, then layer up with the mint, cilantro, carrot, cucumber and lettuce. Add a small handful of the rice noodles, then top with some of the chopped peanuts.

3 Fold the bottom of the roll up over the ingredients, fold in the sides and roll into a neat parcel.

4 To make the dipping sauce, whisk all the ingredients together until the sugar has dissolved. Serve with the summer rolls.

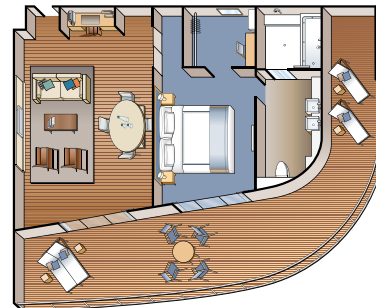

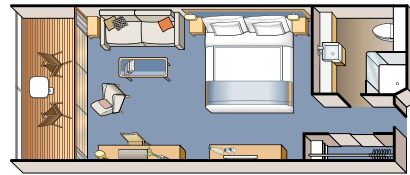

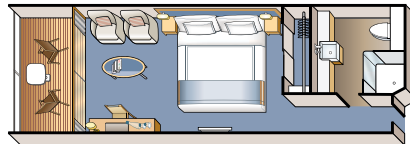

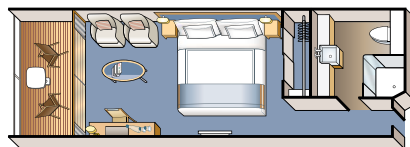

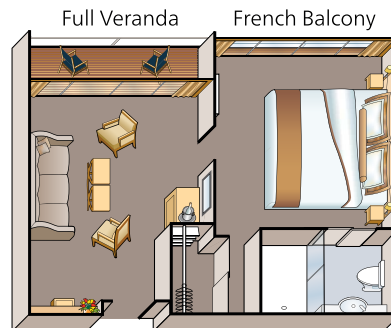

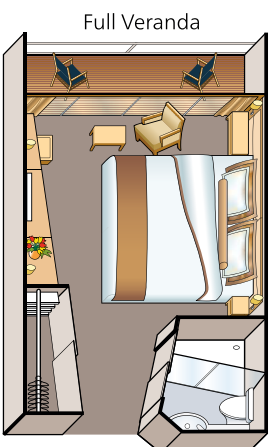


Veranda Stateroom (A, B) | Stateroom size: 205 sq ft

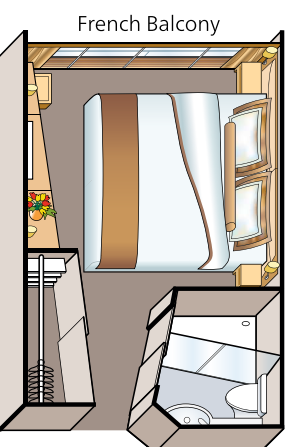

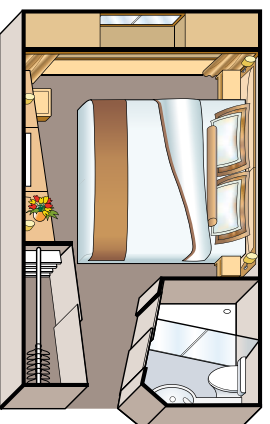

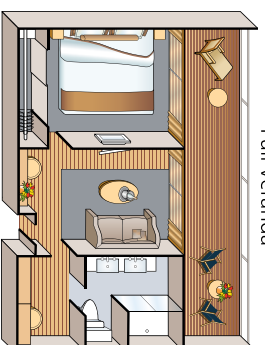

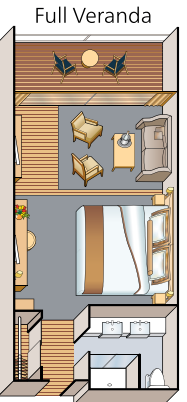

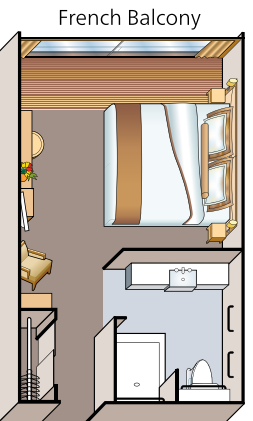

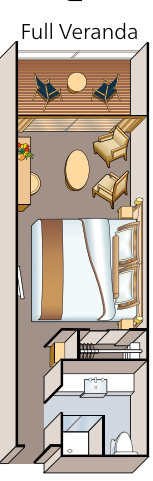
