### SITKA, ALASKA

Snuggled between a mountain range known as the Three Sisters and Sitka Sound, this small town’s natural beauty is nothing short of epic. In the shadow of snow-capped Mount Edgecumbe, Sitka also boasts wonderfully preserved history and a thriving arts community. Founded by fur traders as New Archangel in 1799, Sitka was acquired by the United States of America as the Alaska territory in 1867. Explore the onion-shaped domes and gold-coloured crosses of St. Michael’s Cathedral, a picturesque remnant of Sitka’s heritage. After absorbing centuries of history at the Sitka History Museum, stroll among downtown’s numerous art galleries, shops and restaurants, perhaps stopping for a locally made craft beer. Beneath a canopy of towering hemlock, spruce and cedar trees, behold the 18 totems carved by Tlingit and Haida artists along the remarkable Totem Trail in Sitka National Historical Park.

Visit Omata, once an arrival point for European immigrants, now a successful wine-growing region. Walk among the mighty kauri trees of Puketi Forest, and so much more.

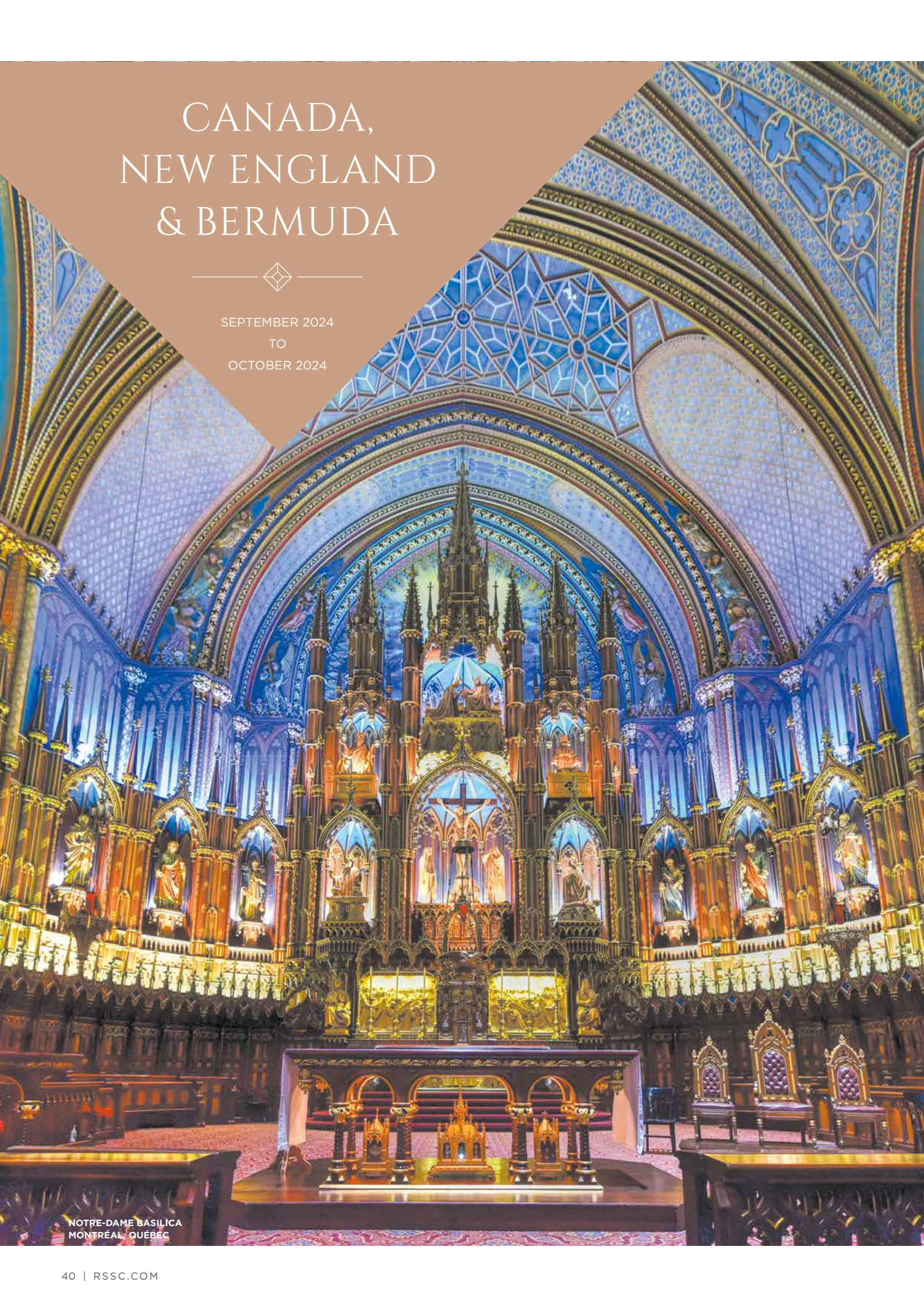

## NEW *Ports of Call*

### CASTELLÓN, SPAIN

This capital city along the Costa del Azahar (Orange Blossom Coast) offers hinterlands and verdant landscapes to complement its beaches. Look for Fadri Tower and the Gothic cathedral in its historic quarter and the medieval walled town of Peñíscola along the north coast.

### MELILLA, SPAIN

One of two autonomous Spanish cities on the Moroccan coast (the other is Ceuta, near Gibraltar), Melilla features a monumental military fortress, a surprising collection of modernist buildings and a unique fusion of Mediterranean, European and African cuisine.

### PORTO SANTO STEFANO, ITALY

Linked to the Tuscan mainland via three isthmuses, Porto Santo Stefano boasts a laid-back seafront that draws summer crowds, a 16th-century military fortress built by the Spanish and an 18th-century convent that offers views of the Tuscan archipelago.

### PONZA, ITALY

Off the coast of Italy's Lazio region, stroll among the wild orchids of Ponza's Botanical Gardens, seek out the island's fascinating mix of Etruscan, Roman, Egyptian and Greek ruins, or simply bask in the wonderfully casual Mediterranean vibe.

### GOZO, MALTA

Discover Gozo's mix of breathtaking natural features, historic fortifications and megalithic temples, from a natural limestone arch called Azure Window to the cathedral and museums of the *Cittadella* (Citadel). Later, sample a local drop at an acclaimed winery.

### LIMNOS, GREECE

Experience Greece at its authentic best on this northern Aegean island of thriving fishing communities, intriguing ancient ruins, secluded stretches of sandy beaches, a medieval hilltop *kastro* (castle) and a wine-making culture mentioned in Homer's *Iliad*.

### SKIATHOS, GREECE








Pine-forested mountains sloping to dazzling, white sand beaches await upon this most popular of the Sporades Islands. Explore Skiathos Town's whitewashed alleys, restaurants and quaint tavernas and the remains of the island's medieval capital of Kastro, abandoned since 1830.

### CESME, TURKEY

Historical treasures abound in this popular Aegean resort town. Explore a 6th-century BCE temple dedicated to the goddess Aphrodite, the ancient ruins of 7th-century BCE Erythrai and magnificent Cesme Castle before people-watching over a Turkish coffee in nearby Alacati.

### DIDIM, TURKEY

Districts named *Altınkum* (Golden Sand), *Gümüşkum* (Silver Sand) and *Sarıkum* (Yellow Sand) reveal Didim's modern appeal, but its most famous ancient monument — the Temple of Apollo in the village of Didyma — was once home to the second most influential oracle after Delphi.

## NEW *Ports of Call*

### DJUPIVOGUR, ICELAND

### SAAREMAA, ESTONIA

Part of an archipelago so diverse and robust it's recognised by UNESCO as a biosphere reserve. The Estonian island of Saaremaa boasts a medieval fortress, traditional villages, elaborate spas — even a meteorite crater field once considered sacred.

### ESBJERG, DENMARK

A Danish version of Easter Island's monoliths — the monumental *Man Meets the Sea* — is a spectacular introduction to this North Sea harbour city. Dive into local history and art at Esbjerg's museums and discover the offshore gem of Fanø.

### CALAIS, FRANCE

A World Heritage-listed city hall fronted by one of Rodin's most famous public monuments, museums dedicated to the city's role in World War II and a medieval watchtower and cathedral make Calais much more than a transportation hub to England.

### MÅLØY, NORWAY

Explore the sights of this charming coastal village that's one of Norway's most important fishing ports. Learn the area's WWII history at the Måløy Raid Centre, snap a photo of the must-see Kannesteinen Rock and walk Refviksanden's white sands.

### AARHUS, DENMARK

Brimming with stunning architecture both old and modern, a vibrant cultural scene and lively boutiques and bars, Denmark's second-largest city is fast becoming a must-see Scandinavian stop. Foodies dive into dishes ranging from New Nordic to traditional Danish.

### SANTANDER, SPAIN

From Magdalena Palace — an early 20th-century gift from Santander to Spain's royal family — to the ultra modern Centro Botín museum, this picturesque port city nicknamed 'bride of the sea' echoes its seafaring past and heralds its future.
