More than 1,000 fjords and 200,000 islands along the world's second longest coastline. The coastal round trip route from Bergen to Kirkenes and back will provide many new experiences. The mountains are immutable, but the weather and the light change constantly transforming the colours and appearance of the landscape. Here you will encounter grey drizzle, crackling green Northern Lights or the soft, golden midnight sun. Along the coast, tiny fishing villages shelter from the fierce Atlantic breakers, while larger coastal towns nestle in the narrow space between wild mountains and the rolling sea.

Sometimes, the experiences are the people you see, e.g. observing the joy of a welcome hug on the quay when the locals come home from their coastal voyage. Other times, it's the sight of mighty mountainous massifs or the expanse of the sea, the salty smell of or the bracing sea air.



# **ROUND TRIP AND TOWARDS THE NORTH**

Whether you are going on the entire round trip or just part of it, new adventures await you every day.



# DAY 1

### PORT: BERGEN

The voyage starts in Bergen, the capital of western Norway, where you can see the colourful, UNESCO-listed warehouses in Bryggen. Take the funicular railway, Fløibanen, up to one of the lookout points, sample the seafood at the fish market or take a stroll through the narrow streets and along the quays of the lively harbour. Bergen is the gateway to the Norwegian fjords and the start of your coastal adventure.



### DAY 2

# PORTS: FLORO-MÅLØY-TORVIK-ÅLESUND-GEIRANGER\*/ HJØRUNDFJORDEN\*-ÅLESUND-MOLDE

After the first night on board, you can start your day by waving to the Havila Voyages headquarters just off Torvik. Ålesund is renowned for its art nouveau architecture with beautiful brick houses and warehouses. In the summer, you can continue to the UNESCO World Heritage Site of Geiranger Fjord, which has steep mountainsides and dramatic waterfalls.

### DAY 3

# PORTS: KRISTIANSUND-TRONDHEIM-RØRVIK

It is morning when we dock in the historic city of Trondheim, which was founded over a thousand years ago. Nidaros Cathedral is the city's major landmark; it is Norway's national shrine and one of the largest cathedrals in northern Europe. After our visit here, the voyage continues out into the fjord towards northern Norway.



# PORTS: BRØNNØYSUND-SANDNESSJØEN-NESNA-ØRNES-BODØ-STAMSUND-SVOLVÆR

On this stretch, we mark crossing the Arctic Circle with a ceremony and continue into the Arctic regions. It means midnight sun in the summer, while winter days are mostly dark day and night, and the possibility of Northern Lights in the evenings. Nature is powerful with northern Scandinavia's largest glacier, the world's strongest tidal current and encounters with the majestic sea eagle. In the evening, Lofoten fishing villages, steep mountains and Vikings in helmets await. Many of these are our own Havila products that you will not find elsewhere.



### DAY 6

# PORTS: HAMMERFEST-HAVØYSUND-HONNINGSVÅG-KJØLLEFJORD-MEHAMN-BERLEVÅG

This is as far north as you can get — by land or sea. For many, the visit to the North Cape is a high point and a goal for voyages along the Norwegian coast. Up here in the polar landscape, nature is at its harshest and most desolate, but between bare plains and rugged cliffs people cling on and reap nature's bounty. You can also have a taste of the catch. How about some king crab?



### DAY 5

# PORTS: STOKMARKNES-SORTLAND-RISØYHAMN-HARSTAD-FINNSNES- TROMSØ-SKJERVØY

The voyage continues on through narrow fjords and past wild mountains to Tromsø, a city associated with hunting and fishing, polar expeditions and courage. Now you have also reached the land of the Sami, Norway's indigenous people. Meeting the Sami and their reindeer and learning about Sami culture is a unique and memorable experience.

### NAV 7

### PORTS: BATSFJORD-VARDO-VADSO - KIRKENES

You are now as far east on your voyage as you can go.

The border with Russia is only a few kilometres away, and the road signs in Kirkenes are in Norwegian and Russian. You can go as far as the border on one of our excursions, or how about a visit to the Snowhotel where everything is made of ice and snow?



# **ROUND TRIP AND TOWARDS THE SOUTH**

### DAY 8

# PORTS: MEHAMN-KJØLLEFJORD-HONNINGSVÅG-HAVØYSUND-HAMMERFEST-ØKSFJORD-SKJERVØY-TROMSØ

The polar landscape changes as we sail west and south again. The great expanses are replaced by steep peaks, and in the evening we sail into Tromsø. You can go to a midnight concert in the Arctic Cathedral, or take a stroll in the midnight sun or under the Northern Lights and explore the nightlife of the city dubbed "The Paris of the North".

### DAY 9

# PORTS: FINNSNES-HARSTAD-RISØYHAMN-SORTLAND-STOKMARKNES-SVOLVÆR-STAMSUND

We return to the wild, idyllic Lofoten Islands. Beneath the jagged mountains lie chalky white sandy beaches and fishing villages with a vibrant fishing industry, and the locals using the coastal ships for everyday trips and transportation. If the weather permits, we will enter the narrow Trollfjord. There is a strong possibility of spotting sea eagles here.

### DAY 10

### PORTS: BODO-ORNES-SANDNESSJØEN-BRONNØYSUND-RORVIK

At this point, we will have come so far south that we will be crossing the Arctic Circle and sailing away from the polar night and the sunlit nights. But you can still see the Northern Lights in the winter, and it is never completely dark during the summer nights. Here you sail past a myriad of small islands, islets and skerries and past the special mountain, Trollhatten, which has a hole in the middle. If you wish, you can also join us for a walk on the mountain and enter the cavern.







### PORTS: TRONDHEIM-KRISTIANSUND-MOLDE-ÅLESUND

We sail through the wide Trondheim fjord that is bounded by rolling farmland on both sides and return to the coast and the open sea. You can disembark in Kristiansund and be driven along the Atlantic Ocean Road, which has been called the world's most beautiful drive. The road meanders along islets and skerries, and afterwards you can re-embark in Molde.


### LAST DAY



At the age of twelve, Per earned his first wages through fishing and bought his first boat just a few years later. This was the start of the Havila Group, which currently employs several thousand workers. The name Havila comes from Havilah in the Bible. Havilah is associated with the Garden of Eden, and its land contains gold.


As your home during your stay with us, the ship provides rest and relaxation as well as activities and experiences


# **SUITES**


# **ACTIVITIES ON BOARD**


On board you can learn about Norwegian history and sample traditional Norwegian food. You will be invited to participate in a fun ceremony to mark the crossing of the Arctic Circle.

The Norwegian coast with its ever-changing views confers an air of tranquillity as it glides slowly by. Sometimes we pass particularly unique places along the coast. We will give you a little advance notice and information about such places. You may perhaps like to enjoy the views through the large windows or you may prefer to do so by going up on deck?

When we pass the Arctic Circle, you are invited out on deck to a playful baptism ceremony by Njord, the Norse god of the sea. During your voyage, you will also be invited to sample traditional Norwegian food.

And if you are interested in learning more about Norwegian history, there are a range of lectures on everything from Havila to how the Norwegian fjords were created to birdlife, Sami culture, witches and the Northern Lights.
















